

### Faith Formation and Parish School GRADE LEVEL PRAYERS

All children in our St. Matthew Parish Community, whether they attend St. Matthew Parish School (SMPS) or Sunday Faith Formation (SFF), are encouraged to <a href="begin">begin</a> learning these basic Catholic prayers at the grade level indicated in the chart below. Regardless of the age at which your child(ren) begin(s) formal faith formation, whether at SMPS or SFF, we recommend that parents, as heads of the Domestic Church (families) and as the first and most important teachers of the Catholic Faith to their children, begin saying these prayers marked PK (Pre-Kindergarten), K (Kindergarten), or grade 1 together with your children from an early age at home. Teachers at SMPS and catechists leading the SFF classes will reinforce the efforts of parents by also saying these prayers in the context of the SMPS school day or SFF classes. In this way, parents as well as the St. Matthew Parish community work together to pass down the deposit of the Catholic Faith to our children.
